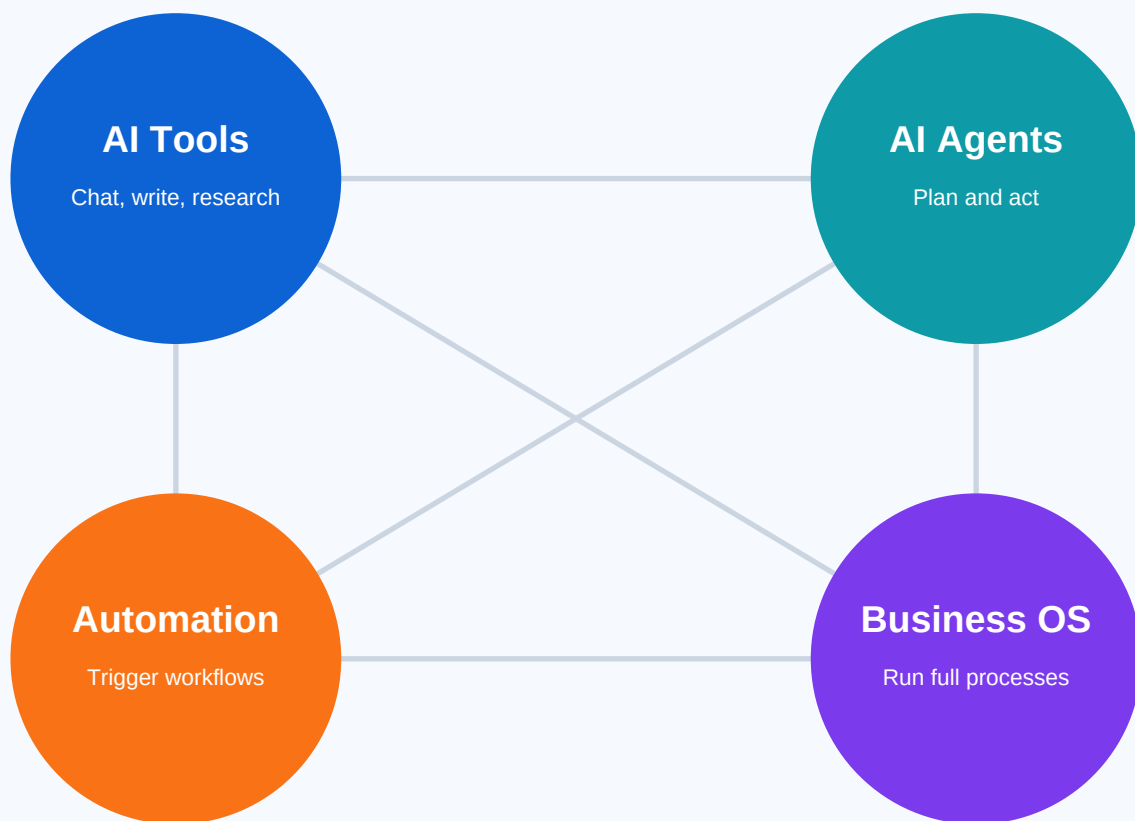

Pictorial 4: What Is Happening in the AI Arena

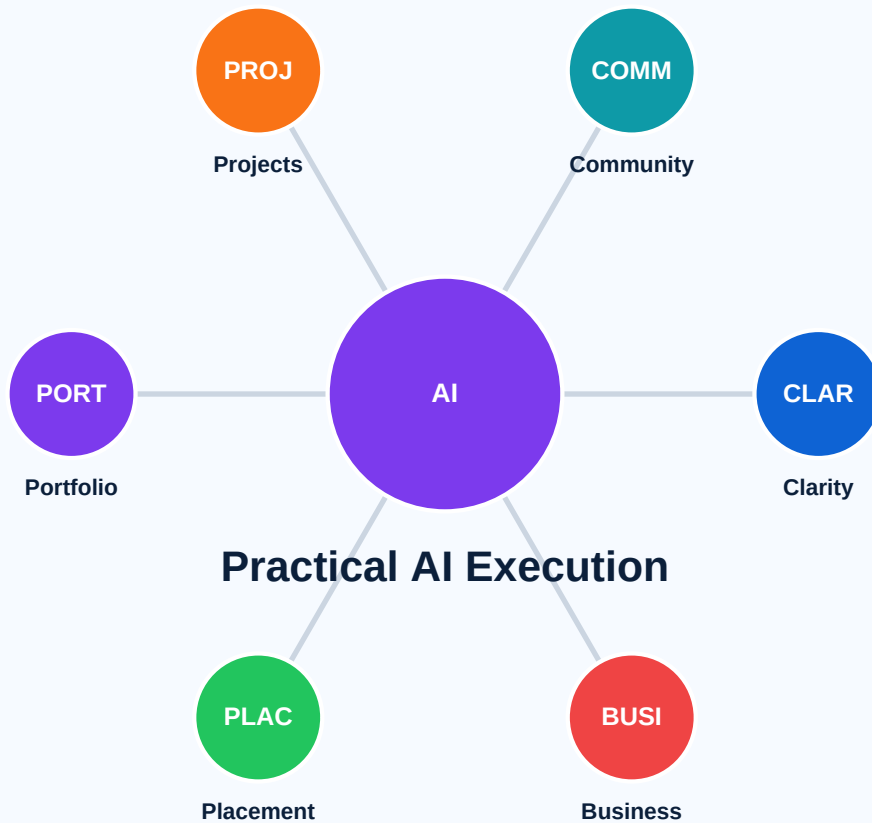
